

Year 10 Individual Speaking Task

You will shortly be asked to give an individual presentation to the class as part of your speaking and listening coursework.

Please read the following to help you prepare for this.

Task:

Give a 5 minute presentation on a topic of your choice.

You can pick any topic that you are interested in such as a hobby, sport or area of interest- eg a band/ a type of music/ a subject you are interested in/ a sport you play or follow/ a film or film-maker/ cars or car racing etc.

The subject chosen must be appropriate for being presented to the class. Anything deemed to be offensive or inappropriate will be disallowed and you will have to do it all over again.

You should aim to use presentation aids to help you in your presentation- eg video or DVD clips; extracts of CDs; posters; books; overhead projector slides etc.

Apart from giving the talk, you should be prepared to be asked questions by your audience at the end.

Work for lessons on 3 and 4 March

1. 3 March: decide on a topic on which to give your talk and make initial plans on content. You should think about what resources/ sources of information you may wish to use and bring any in tomorrow (4 March) to work on in the lesson.
2. 4 March: plan out your talk and if you feel you have to, draft out your talk on paper. You also need to prepare a prompt card for your talk.

You should not waste your time in these lessons- you will not be getting much other time in lessons to work on this and we will be starting drawing lots for the talks next week.
